



EC Declaration of Conformity

REACH EC 1907/2006 Registration, evaluation, authorization and restriction of chemical substances

Herewith we inform you about the latest update on the REACH regulation.

The EC Regulation No 1907/2006 – REACH, covering the registration, evaluation, authorisation and restriction of chemical substances entered into force in June 2007 with the purpose of protecting human health and environment.

The European Chemicals Agency ECHA has published an initial Candidate List of “Substances of Very High Concerns” or SVHC in October 2008 and has since then updated the list every 6 months. The latest update from January 2021 includes **211** substances.

Neutrik confirms that the products we put on the market do not contain one of these substances above a maximum concentration of 0.1% by weight in the articles, other than the items mentioned below.

- copper products like XLR, plugs and jacks as well as speakON and powerCON comprising copper alloys such as brass contain the substance lead greater than 0.1% (CAS 7439-92-1, EC No. 231-100-4) according to the Directive 2011/65/EC.

Regarding substances listed in annex XIV, XVII and the article 33 of EC 1907/2006 Neutrik confirms that articles comply to this regulation.

This declaration is based on the monitoring of our supply chain. Once new information is available, an update will be made accordingly.
